Lance Ollenberger is the Vice President, Operations with the British Columbia Oil and Gas Commission. In this role Lance is responsible for delivery of a comprehensive Compliance and Enforcement regime, responsible for all provincially regulated oil and gas operations in the province of BC. Lance is the primary decision maker on all decisions regarding administrative monetary penalties, and has been tasked with developing a variety of processes around this relatively new administrative penalty system (7 years old), including file management, investigative procedures, and the consistent implementation of these processes. He oversees the work of approximately 30 staff members.

Lance has spent over 30 years in the realm of Natural Resource sector regulatory affairs. He previously spent time with BC's Ministry of Forests, where he was both a District Compliance Leader, and the BC Provincial Enforcement Manager. Lance also contributes to the furthering of administrative law principles through his work with the Law Society of British Columbia hearing panel, and he also serves on the BC Common Ground Alliance Board of Directors.
